Audio 1 (21 seconds)

“One of the things we see is if livestock owners are renting/leasing pasture, or working off farm, or travelling out of the area it would be extremely helpful if they would leave their contact information with the land owners, neighbours, family members that still reside in the area.”

Audio 2 (21 seconds)

“One of the things that would be helpful for contact information would be providing a home phone number, a work phone number, or a cell phone number and also to provide the name of their veterinarian. So if we’re called to the property on what might be the downer animal we can contact the veterinarian who is familiar with that particular herd or that particular animal”

Audio 3 (13 seconds)

“If the livestock owners would have this information available to other people who are nearby that’s where we would start our canvass to who owns these animals, how can I contact that person?”

Audio 4 (11 seconds)

“They can go to the local RCMP detachments or they can call AFAC – Alberta Farm Animal Care with their concerns and have them addressed by other agencies as well.”
