Audio 1 (21 seconds)

“They can call our 1-800# 1-800-455-9003 and place a complaint with our central dispatch. The central dispatch will take the complaint and all the information from the individual and will dispatch one of our Peace Officers. A member of our animal protection services will have to go out and check on the animal.”

Audio 2 (17 seconds)

“ALERT is important to mention because sometimes people are not sure about a situation. Maybe they don’t believe the animal is in distress but they just not quite sure so they can call the ALERT line. Their number is 1-800-506-2273 and this is really a system where producers help producers.”

Audio 3 (18 seconds)

“There are many, many areas for an individual to call if they have a belief that there is an animal that is not well. Again they can call the ALERT line; they can certainly call the Alberta SPCA. We’re just a phone call away. This is our collective job to ensure that no animals suffer or that animals don’t continue to suffer.”
